Dr. Sam Storms is a native of Oklahoma. He was raised in a Southern Baptist church and came to faith in Christ as a child. He holds degrees from the University of Oklahoma, Dallas Seminary, and the University of Texas at Dallas. He has served as an associate pastor at Believers Chapel in

Dallas; senior pastor of Christ Community Church in Ardmore, OK; associate pastor and president of Grace Training Center at Metro Christian Fellowship in Kansas City; and Visiting Associate Professor of Theology at Wheaton College. He presently carries on a ministry of speaking and writing called Enjoying God Ministries (www.enjoyinggodministries.com). Sam is the author of a number of books and articles, including *The Grandeur of God: A Theological and Devotional Study of the Divine Attributes*; *To Love Mercy: Becoming a Person of Compassion, Acceptance, & Forgiveness*; *One Thing: Developing a Passion for the Beauty of God*; and *Pleasures Evermore: The Life-Changing Power of Enjoying God*. Sam and his wife, Ann, live in the Kansas City area. They have two daughters and two grandsons.
