The EFCA Ministerial Association has invited four evangelical scholars to make presentations at our 10th Midwinter Ministerial Theological Discussion. Each one is committed to inerrancy while holding to different positions on the millennium. So that we might better understand critical differences between these four positions, we have asked them to identify the hermeneutical principles they follow, apply those principles to assigned passages of Scripture, and interact with one another. The interaction should provide all of us with insight into our own approach to the interpretation of Scripture. Equally important, we will have had the opportunity to evaluate the validity of the approach taken by others who wrestle with the same inerrant texts as we do.

Based on the Resolution passed at the National Leadership Conference, the Spiritual Heritage Committee continues to work on behalf of the EFCA Board of Directors to prepare a Third Draft Revision of the EFCA Statement of Faith. The dialogue generated by the Midwinter theme of Inerrancy, Hermeneutics, and Eschatology will be of great interest to them.

We know that many of you are being called upon to make presentations on views of the millennium as you and your church participate in discussions on a revised Statement of Faith. Each person who attends will be given audio recordings of the presentations and other materials intended to help you create productive discussions.

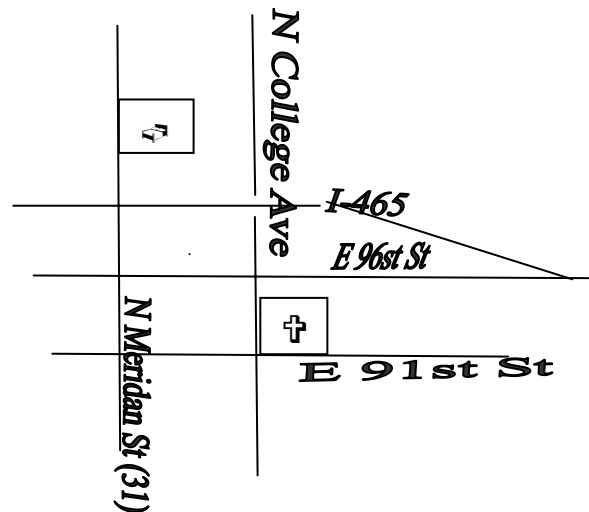
